Evacuation from Kyiv region in March 2022




Destroyed healthcare facilities

- 283 hospitals completely destroyed
- **1318** damaged by 50-90%
- 896 pharmacies completely destroyed
- 1050 ambulances were destroyed or burned after rocket attacks



• 360 medics died on the job while providing care to patients






Russia kills doctors!

Reality and forecasts

Reality

- > impossibility to visit a family doctor or get help online
- > increase in heart attacks and strokes among people ages 40 -45
- complicated laboratory tests, planned operations, supportive therapy
- > a decrease in number of screenings, so oncology is diagnosed at late stages
- increase in lung diseases, tuberculosis due to staying in dark, cold, wet rooms and unbalanced diet
- > 14 million Ukrainian need psychological help
- > increasing self-medication, abuse of painkillers and sedatives



To protect against Russian attacks, the elections were held in shelter




- 60.000 people per day women, children and the elderly arrived to Lviv in spring 2022. All of them needed the help of psychologist and doctor
- Employees of our University joined the volunteer association "Medical and psychological help" and were constantly on duty at the railway station: they stopped panic attacks, gave advice, medicine, referred to hospitals. Students assisted them and looked for the children so that their mothers could get some sleep

Volunteer association on Lviv railway station and its psychologist Olga Shved who is on duty at night and on weekends because she teaches students during the day



- Our doctors cooperated with their colleagues from Poland and other countries
- Doctors conducted the necessary examinations, restored medical history, psychologists stabilized the emotional state of patients and their relatives
- Students worked as support staff, nurses, they sorted medicines etc.
- After some days sick children were transported to Poland or other countries

Sick children with oncology, nephrology and orphan diseases were evacuated to Lviv to the Western Ukrainian Children's Specialized Medical Center (WUChSMC)





In this way, 1460 seriously ill children were saved. Because in the conditions of continuous Russian shelling and missile strikes, it was impossible to provide full treatment in Ukraine





Ointments against burns and skin lesions, individual hemostatic (tourniquets) as well as hydrogel bandages are made in the laboratories of the University



- 12-year-old Yana lost two legs after a Russian missile attack on the railway station in Kramatorsk
- The girl was treated in Lviv, and prosthetics were made in the USA







- 6-year-old Oleksandra lost her leg after a Russian rocket hit her home
